

Retinal Detachment Warning Signs

The doctor has determined that you are at risk for a retinal detachment.

Call our office immediately if you have any symptoms described below:

1. An increase in the spots, cobwebs, floaters, or dots that you see.
2. Flashes of light, or sparks, in your side vision. These flashes are not very bright and are best seen in dim light.
3. A shadow or gray area in your vision.

Please check for these signs in your vision, one eye at a time. If you notice any of these signs, please call our office **immediately** at **901-754-3937**.

If you have a retinal tear or detachment, and you do not seek help quickly, you may suffer the loss of your vision.
